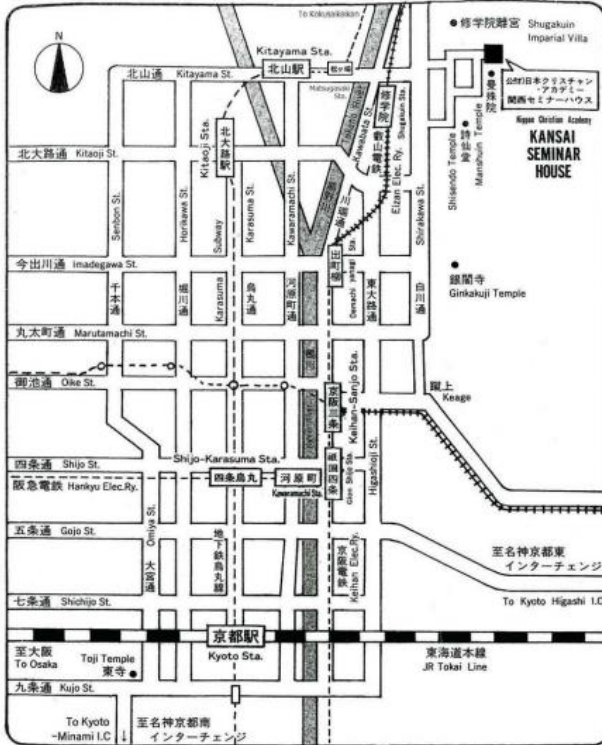
1. You can participate at any time (Activities, BBQ, 2nd day).
